

Advertisements & Sponsorship Signs

All sponsorship signs or banners intended to be affixed to fencing, structures, or staked in the ground must be submitted in sample design form and approved by the County prior to production and placement and are subject to removal at the discretion of the County at any time. Signs and banners must be temporary and can be displayed at the beginning of each season and must be taken down no later than one week after the season is over. They may not block the view of the public, cause a distraction, or obscure any County signs.

- Signs must be vinyl with holes/grommets and secured at each corner by zip ties with no protruding edges. No guy wires allowed.
- Signs must be **no larger** than 3 feet by 6 feet in area.
- The affiliated organization (PYAA, Little League, PSA, Lacrosse, etc.) must ensure that the advertiser agrees to strictly comply with all laws respecting copyright, royalties, and trademarks and shall not infringe on any related statutory, common law, or other right of any person or entity.
- The County is not responsible for weather, graffiti, theft, or vandalism. Each affiliated organization must ensure signs are presentable at all times. If the sign(s) becomes worn or vandalized, the organization must make repairs or remove the sign(s) within 48 hours of notification by the County or be subject to removal and possibly disposal by the County.
- The County prohibits the advertising of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, pornographic, or inappropriate material.

The County shall have final approval of all advertising materials and placement and reserves the right to accept or reject any advertising at its sole discretion.
